Zimbabweans are being encouraged to report suspicious activity before, after and during elections. You can report suspicious activity any of the places below.

All reports received by Zimbabwe Election 2018 will be treated in a private and confidential manner. We may ask legal authorities to investigate further, but we will NEVER give away any of your personal information including your name or contact details without your permission.

#### Suspicious Activity to Look Out For

- Recording of BVR serial numbers.
- Ballot Box Stuffing.
- Counting Errors.
- Tampering with ballot boxes.
- Suspicious activity when transporting ballot papers, ballot boxes or other election material.
- Assistance of voters who are capable of voting for themselves.
- Interference by Chiefs, Traditional Leaders or Election Observers
- Interference by Army, Police or other authorities
- Being Turned Away from Registration for suspicious reasons.
- Being Turned Away from voting for suspicious reasons.
- Your name not on the voters roll if you have a new BVR slip.
- Excessively long queues on voting day.
- Political Intimidation or Violence of any kind.
- Threats or individuals telling you who to vote for.
- Seizure of ID Documents or Registration Slip.
- Being able to easily wash off indelible ink from your finger after voting.
- Observing people who have voted more than once.
- Failure of ZEC to post election results outside the polling station.
- Any other activity which you think is suspicious.
